

Please read the programme information on the www.isr.ch/scholarship website. Only eligible students will be considered for full or partial financial scholarship, and annual tax returns will be required to prove income. Students who apply for the ISR Academic Scholarship Programme must fulfil the following requirements:

- Are legal residents and tax domiciled in the region from which applying (Austria, Liechtenstein or Switzerland) and
- Live within a 60-minute commute of ISR
- They are in Grade 9 at the time of application for entry into Grade 10 in the following August
- They have a Cambridge English language level of B2, or above
- Students whose financial situation is defined as below are eligible to apply:
